Reports and recommendations of Committees

1. <u>Discussion and action on legislative agenda for 2021 as presented by Lisa Hughes and Pat Haggerty.</u>

Ms. Hughes and Mr. Haggerty reviewed the legislative recommendations that are proposed by the Pension Review Board for the upcoming 2021 Legislative Session. No action was taken.

Unfinished Business

New Business

Chairman Shelton requested that Item 4 be moved before Item 1. There were no objections.

4. Discussion and action on private equity investment with Audax Private Equity Fund IV.

Mr. Chew explained that the Fund invested in Audax Fund IV in 2012 with a \$3M commitment. It is reaching its end of life. It has done well with a 14% net IRR. There still remains platform investments with protentional value. Audax is proposing a new 5-year vehicle. Meketa still has not completed their review and do not have a formal recommendation for the Fund. Audax is requesting an answer from the Fund by December 9th which is prior to the next Board meeting.

After careful discussion and due consideration, Ms. Banks moved to send the recommendation from Meketa to the Investment Committee prior to the next Board meeting and allow the Investment Committee to make the final decision. This was seconded by Mr. Borsch and passed unanimously by the Board.

1. <u>Investment Performance Review for the period ended December 31, 2019 and update, as presented by Ms. Amy Wesly, and Mr. Alec Cote of Metropolitan Real Estate.</u>

Due to a scheduling conflict, Metropolitan Real Estate was unable to make today's meeting but will be present at the December meeting.

2. <u>Investment Performance Review for the period ended December 31, 2019 and update, as presented by Mr. Ralph Canada, Mr. Scott Egarian, Mr. Marc Weiss, and Ms. Margaret McVey of Partners Group.</u>

Partners Group is focused on cities with strong GDP, population, and job growth; properties with strong tenants; logistics and residential properties; and distressed hospitality assets. They avoid taking speculative development risk; retail and most operational property types; excessive leverage or senior debt with mezzanine debt; and emerging markets.

The Fund is invested in four programs with Partners Group: PG Global Real Estate 2008, PG Global Real Estate 2011, PG Global Real Estate 2014, and PG Real Estate Secondary 2017. As of September 2017, the net IRR for each program is as follows: 3.8%, 6.9%, 8.7% and 9.3%.

3. <u>Presentation and review of third quarter Investment Performance, as presented by Mr. Trevor Jackson and Mr. Tony Kay of AndCo Consulting.</u>

The 3rd quarter returns were positive continuing in their rebound from the 2nd quarter. US equites posted positive returns led by large cap stocks. Growth cap stocks maintained their

dominance relative to value-oriented stocks. The Pension Fund was up 5.98% for the quarter and ranked in the sixteenth percentile among peer groups.
